May 2024 Election Results for the Board of Directors

42 valid ballots were returned in the 2024 Board of Directors election. There were 3 open positions. At the Annual Meeting held on May 15th, it was announced that Chase Stockfisch was voted in to take over the President role and Don Tetreault was elected to serve as Treasurer for another term. Ray Schulte will serve the next term as the Vice President. Bob Walters and Freddi Dahn are serving the second year of a 2-year term as ACC Chair and Secretary respectively.

Annual Assessment Fees

The Board reviews and sets a goal for our required reserve account each year. This goal is increased every year by the prevailing inflation rate and estimated sewer system wear-and-tear. The intent is to have sufficient cash on hand to cover one year's annual expenses and any unforeseen expenses that might arise in order not to require the need for a special assessment.

The Board has set a reserve goal of \$135,000 and an additional \$10,000 for 2024/2025 operating expenses. The Board has set the 2024 annual assessment fee to remain the same at \$180.00 in order to maintain this goal. For your information, the majority of our funds are in CD's paying over 5%.

Lets talk Grinder Pumps

It's a good idea to get your grinder pump serviced at least once a year. Sewer information and some contractors that service low pressure grinder pump systems are listed on the website on the News/Financial page:

The last complete sewer line flush was completed on September 11, 2023.

Another important note - Should we experience a prolonged power outage, please remember that the grinder pumps operate with electricity. Our tanks are typically only about 300-400 gallons which will fill up very quickly if not operating. To avoid a backup into the house, be mindful on your water usage.

Garbage & Refuse Reminder

As stated in Section 18.5 of the Blackhawk CC&Rs:

"...All equipment for the storage or disposal of such waste materials [rubbish, trash, garbage or other waste] shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition and shall be enclosed so as not to be visible from any street or any other lot except when placed on the curbing on days regularly scheduled for the purpose of collection." **Everyone please keep your trash cans out of sight!**

Another important reminder; starting the week of October 14th our trash collection day will switch to Tuesdays. Everyone should have received a notice in the mail from the City of Prescott.
